2019 – Parking Policy

Please read through this information concerning parking at the First Baptist Church of Mansfield.

Parking Policy:

The parking agreement is for the benefit of both the individual and the church, we are not a parking business. We realize that there is need to use the church parking lot and we ask that you respect the needs of the church and we will treat you and your car with respect. We ask that individuals who use our parking lot give back with a financial donation of \$400 per semester. Semesters are Fall (Aug. 20-Jan. 10), Spring (Jan.10- May 20), and Summer (May 21-Aug. 10).

Important Points to Parking at FBCM

Winter parking: Our parking lot is plowed commercially please respect the effort we put into keeping our lot cleared. If your car is plowed in it is your responsibility to clear the area surrounding your car and put the snow appropriately off the lot.

Safe driving: No inappropriate driving or disrespectful behavior will be tolerated. You will be asked not to park here anymore.

Parking Pass info: Parkers will be issued a “pass” and a “spot”. You can pick up the pass when you first come to park. Your car/license plate will also be registered with the church. Either way, please introduce yourself, as we like to meet each parker. ***Keep your “Pass” visible.*** Your “Pass” is ***not transferable*** for other cars to use.

BEFORE you fill out the Application:

The one requirement to parking at FBCM: If we have an event, such as a funeral, wedding, or other large event, where all spaces at the church are needed, you may be asked to move your vehicle for a designated amount of time.

How to Apply:

First, contact the chairman of the trustees, listed below, to confirm that there is space available. Next, please complete the Parking Request Form, sign both accountability spots, include your check or money order, then:

3. Pick up your signed permit and display it on your vehicle dashboard and park in the designated area.
